All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada will be given priority. Memorial University is committed to employment equity and encourages applications from qualified women and men, visible minorities, aboriginal people, and persons with disabilities.

Additional information: The **Department of Classics** invites applications for an **8-month teaching term appointment** to begin September 1, 2018. The successful applicant will be expected to teach six courses (three per semester), including courses in mythology, Latin and/or Greek, and other Greek and Roman studies courses.
