1. RECENT AND UP-COMING ISSUES.

19.1 Regular Issue. Three articles, one item in “Echos du monde classique”, and six book reviews.

2. PUBLICATION SCHEDULE

The publication schedule remains slightly off. We hope to have 20.1 and 20.2 to the press before the end of the calendar year.

3. SUBMISSION RATES

There have been 15 submissions to the journal since May 2022. They are coming in to both the electronic system and to the *Mouseion* email address (about 50-50). Some scholars (especially if their affiliation is somewhat irregular) have found using ScholarOne challenging. In addition to Canadian submissions, we have also received submissions from Italy, Spain, Greece, Norway, and Jordan. Of these, one has been rejected, one accepted, and most are still under review or revision.

4. FINANCES

Mouseion's finances are currently in fairly good shape. The full report we intended to have for the AGM in May has been delayed by the strike by CRA employees. The report from the treasurer, Kevin Solez, is an interim one. Fortunately, *Mouseion's* finances were able to sponsor a reception at the conference this year.

5. CHANGES IN BOARD MEMBERSHIP

Peter O'Brien will be stepping away from the board at the end of this academic year. The remaining editors are very grateful for his service and his friendship since he joined the board in 2015.
